HOCHTIEF Group Company Turner awarded USD 1.2 billion contract to redevelop Austin Convention Center in a joint venture

The expansion will refurbish and enlarge the Convention Center

HOCHTIEF Group Company Turner has acquired another major contract in the USA. A joint venture team of Turner Construction Company and JE Dunn Construction was awarded a contract to lead a \$1.2 billion redevelopment and expansion of the Austin Convention Center in Texas.

The project will involve demolishing and rebuilding the Convention Center over four years. The expansion and redevelopment will nearly double the amount of rentable space allowing the Convention Center to remain competitive in the marketplace. The redevelopment will also deliver a community-friendly event space that will transform the southeast quadrant of downtown and provide connectivity between downtown and East Austin.

HOCHTIEF CEO Juan Santamaría: "Turner is one of the market leaders in the construction of sports and event properties and is number one in the USA for sustainable, green buildings. This major contract is an excellent opportunity for us to combine our expertise in both areas."

"This project will revitalize the Austin Convention Center, improving the experience for clients and guests alike, while improving the connectivity of downtown Austin. Construction will be complete in 2028.
