## Turner and New York City FC Break Ground on \$780 Million Etihad Park

The start of construction for New York City's first-ever professional soccer-specific stadium and the future home of New York City FC marks a transformative moment for the City and the sport.



January 14, 2024 – Turner Construction Company and New York City FC have officially broken ground on Etihad Park, a \$780 million, state-of-the-art stadium in Willets Point, Queens.
